He has played a major part in elevating glass from a material used primarily for industrial purposes to a highly collectable art form. As an avid beachcomber, Peter is endlessly fascinated by the natural world, often drawing inspiration for his glass art. He is also heavily influenced by the manmade; a stone wall on a snowy day, the London skyline, and often by painters he admires. He achieves consummate works of art which express both painterly and sculptural values.

Exhibiting with her father, Sophie Layton is an established printmaker, relatively new to glass art. Sophie explores light with the aim to create expression through the use of subtle colour and a rich painterly quality in print. Her use of vibrant colour, together with a fascination for the refractive and reflective qualities of glass runs in the family.

Work will also be on display by London Glassblowing resident artists Tim Rawlinson and Bruce Marks. Tim has established himself internationally as a leading glass artist. He has created his own language with his simple geometric forms, using a combination of blown, cast and polished techniques. His fascination with the relationship between light and glass heavily influences his work, leading him to develop the transparent quality of the medium. Bruce will display his ongoing series 'Birds' which has been hugely successful, and its evolution has attracted an avid and enthusiastic public following.

Belair House Picnic Day 12-5pm or relax in the Village Orchard at the Wild Teddy Bear's picnic 12-4pm.

Continue into the Village to see Janet Whittaker hosting six artists in Pickwick Road • 5 and then drop into Romeo Jones for a coffee, whilst enjoying Janet Tod's colourful still life paintings • 8.

Next, enjoy a cheese tasting at Heritage Cheese 2 and two more artists in Calton Ave 3 & 4.

Just around the corner, visit the Festival pop up, with four displaying artists and the 30th Festival Commemorative Exhibition ●1.

Still want more fun? Strictly Swing with King Groovy & the Horn Stars play at St Barnabas Parish Hall at 7.30pm.




